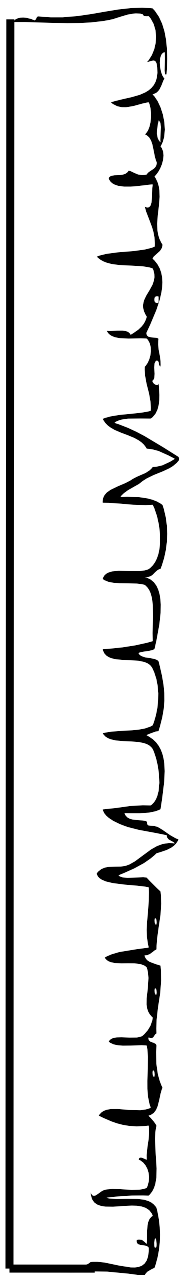

## Sir Flossmore's Mouth Model

“Right! Simply cut out the rows of teeth on this page and paste or tape them into the gums you made with your teacher.”



Notice that your teeth look different from one another. That is because they are designed to do different things!

See if you can find these teeth:

**Incisors.** These are the teeth in the very front. They're the sharpest teeth because they are built to cut food and they are shaped to move it into your mouth.

**Canines.** The pointy teeth in the corners of your mouth. They're meant for grasping and tearing food.

**Molars** are the last teeth towards the back of your mouth. Molars have big, flat chewing surfaces because their job is to chew and grind food into smaller pieces.

There are 16 “Pearly Whites” in each row of adult teeth. It’s alright if you don’t have that many right now. Your first teeth or “baby teeth” have only 10 in each row and they will stay with you until you are about 7 years old, when your adult teeth start to grow in.
